- Kim informed us that they are still working on trail to connect to North Coventry trail.

**Agenda Item: New Business**

- Schuylkill River Trail
  - David Stauffe, Chester County Depart of Facilities & Parks; Mark Wilson, Wilson Consulting Group; Brian Styche, Chester County Planning Commission, attended meeting to review their plans for placement of the trail through township property (Tow Path Park, Heyser tract).

- Trail is completed up to Linfield and would pick up at the Towpath Park. Original plan calls for it to follow Towpath trail and then along 724 through the park. They would like to change original plans and move the trail further from the road, placing it on the park side of the embankment. Park & Rec Committee approved.
- Trail would continue through Heyser Tract close to river?????. A parking area would be constructed.
- Formal easement with township would be documented.
- Trail to be 10' wide macadam trail, 2' gutter one both sides.
