Action Items:

Jane Davidson's report for February:

1. Phase I Environmental Site Assessment report. The clarification letter has been written and forwarded to Bernie Rodgers. The Frick's Locks historic village is listed on the National Register of Historic Places and not the National Historic Landmark list as described in the environmental report. The difference had to be explained and written in a letter. In addition, a request was made to attach the letter to the report as a permanent document.
2. Feasibility study: Applications are being prepared to obtain grants to fund a feasibility study for part of Frick's Locks that in all probability will be the responsibility of East Coventry Township.
3. From the January Report: The Act 14 Notification of January 24, 2012 was received from Rettew (Exelon Consultant) regarding the permit for the wetlands.

New Business:

- Open Space Committee Meeting update was held on February 1, 2012. Rosemarie Miller represented the Historic Commission.

- The County is planning a lecture series to be included as part of the Town Tour and Village Walks. Brochures should be out soon.
