ORDINANCE NO. 2018-224

“Stop Intersections Amendments”

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF EAST COVENTRY TOWNSHIP, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, CHAPTER 15 (MOTOR VEHICLES), PART 2 (TRAFFIC REGULATIONS), SECTION 15-209 (STOP INTERSECTIONS ESTABLISHED) BY DELETING FROM SECTION 15-209.1.B THE INTERSECTION NAMED “EAST CEDARVILLE ROAD, SOUTH SANATOGA ROAD AND SANATOGA ROAD” FROM THE EXISTING LIST OF 2-WAY STOP INTERSECTIONS AND AMENDING SECTION 15-209.1.D (4-WAY STOP INTERSECTIONS) TO ADD “EAST CEDARVILLE ROAD, SOUTH SANATOGA ROAD AND SANATOGA ROAD” TO THE LIST OF 4-WAY STOP INTERSECTIONS.

The Board of Supervisors of East Coventry Township does hereby **ENACT** and **ORDAIN** as follows:

SECTION I. – Amendment to Code.

The Code of Ordinances of East Coventry Township, Chapter 15 (Motor Vehicles), Part 2 (Traffic Regulations), Section 15-209 (Stop Intersections Established) is hereby amended by deleting from Section 15-209.1.B (2-Way Stop Intersections) the following Intersection:

Intersection Name	Stop Control Approaches
East Cedarville Road, South Sanatoga Road and Sanatoga Road	Northwest East Cedarville Road Northeast South Sanatoga Road Southwest Sanatoga Road

SECTION II. – Amendment to Code.

The Code of Ordinances of East Coventry Township, Chapter 15 (Motor Vehicles), Part 2 (Traffic Regulations), Section 15-209 (Stop Intersections Established) Section 15-209.1.D

(4-Way Stop Intersections) is hereby amended by adding the following to the list of 4-way stop intersections:

Intersection Name	Stop Control Approaches
East Cedarville Road, South Sanatoga Road and Sanatoga Road	Northwest East Cedarville Road Northeast South Sanatoga Road Southwest Sanatoga Road Southeast East Cedarville Road

SECTION III. – Severability

The provisions of this Ordinance are severable, and if any section, sentence, clause, part or provision hereof shall be held illegal, invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision of the court shall not affect or impair the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, parts or provisions of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the intent of the Board that this Ordinance would have been adopted even if such illegal, invalid or unconstitutional section, sentence, clause, part or provision had not been included herein.

SECTION IV. – Failure to Enforce not a Waiver

The failure of the Township to enforce any provision of this Ordinance shall not constitute a waiver by the Township of its rights of future enforcement hereunder.

SECTION V. – Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval as required by the law.


SECTION VI. – Repealer

NOTICE is hereby given that the Board of Supervisors of East Coventry Township, at its public meeting on September 10, 2018 at the Township Building, 855 Ellis Woods Road, Pottstown, Pennsylvania, will consider and could vote to adopt an ordinance amending the Codified Ordinances of East Coventry Township, Chester County, Pennsylvania, Chapter 15 (Motor Vehicles), Part 2 (Traffic Regulations), Section 15-209 (Stop Intersections Established) by deleting from Section 15-209.1.B the intersection named “East Cedarville Road, South Sanatoga Road and Sanatoga Road” from the existing list of 2-way stop intersections and amending Section 15-209.1.D (4-way stop intersections) to add East Cedarville Road, South Sanatoga Road and Sanatoga Road to the list of 4-way stop intersections.
