ORDINANCE NO. 203

AN ORDINANCE OF EAST COVENTRY TOWNSHIP, CHESTER COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST COVENTRY, CHAPTER 15 (MOTOR VEHICLES), PART 2 (TRAFFIC REGULATIONS), SECTION 201 (MAXIMUM SPEED LIMITS ESTABLISHED ON CERTAIN STREETS) IN ORDER TO ESTABLISH A SPEED LIMIT OF 25 MILES PER HOUR ON LINWOOD CIRCLE AND AMENDING SECTION 209 (STOP INTERSECTIONS ESTABLISHED) IN ORDER TO ESTABLISH STOP INTERSECTIONS AT THE EASTERN INTERSECTION OF LINWOOD CIRCLE AND EBELHARE ROAD ON LINWOOD CIRCLE TRAVELING NORTHWESTERLY AND THE WESTERN INTERSECTION OF LINWOOD CIRCLE AND EBELHARE ROAD ON LINWOOD CIRCLE TRAVELING NORTHWESTERLY.

The Board of Supervisors of East Coventry Township does hereby **ENACT** and **ORDAIN** as follows:

SECTION I – Amendment to the Code

The Code of Ordinances of the Township of East Coventry, Chapter 15 (Motor Vehicles), Part 2 (Traffic Regulations), Section 201 (Maximum Speed Limits Established on Certain Streets) is hereby amended by adding Linwood Circle to the existing list of speed limits as follows:

Street	Between	Maximum Speed Limit
Linwood Circle	Entire length	25 mph

SECTION II – Amendment to the Code

The Code of Ordinances of the Township of East Coventry, Chapter 15 (Motor Vehicles) Part 2 (Traffic Regulations) Section 209 (Stop Intersections Established) is hereby amended by adding the following to the existing subparagraph A one-way stop intersections as follows:

Stop Street Name	Direction of Travel	Intersecting Street	Additional Description
Linwood Circle	Northwesterly	Ebelhare Road	Eastern Intersection of Linwood Circle and Ebelhare Road
Linwood Circle	Northwesterly	Ebelhare Road	Western Intersection of Linwood Circle and Ebelhare Road

SECTION III – Severability

The provisions of this Ordinance are intended to be severable, and if any section, sentence, clause, part or provision hereof shall be held illegal, invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision of the court shall not affect or impair the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, parts or provisions of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the intent of the Board of Supervisors that this Ordinance would have been adopted even if such illegal, invalid or unconstitutional section, sentence, clause, part or provision had not been included herein.

SECTION IV - Failure to Enforce not a Waiver

The failure of the Township to enforce any provision of this Ordinance shall not constitute a waiver by the Township of its rights of future enforcement hereunder.

SECTION V - Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval as required by the law.


SECTION VI - Repealer

All other ordinances and resolutions or parts thereof insofar as they are inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.


