**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE RADIOLOGICAL EMERGENCY RESPONSE PLAN FOR  
INCIDENTS AT THE LIMERICK NUCLEAR GENERATING STATION**

WHEREAS, Section 7503 of the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Services Code, 35 PA. C.S. Section 7101 et seq. mandates that municipalities prepare, maintain and keep current a Radiological Emergency Response Plan for the prevention and minimization of injury and damage caused by a major emergency or disaster at the Limerick Nuclear Generating Station; and

WHEREAS, in response to the mandate stated above, this municipality has prepared a Radiological Emergency Response Plan to provide prompt and effective emergency response procedures to be followed in the event of a major emergency or disaster at the Limerick Nuclear Generating Station; and


WHEREAS, this municipality has also prepared an emergency operations plan in order to reduce the potential effects of major emergency or disaster and to protect the health, safety and welfare of the residents of this municipality; and

WHEREAS, this plan shall be reviewed every two years to make certain that it conforms to the requirements of the Chester County Emergency Operation Guideline.






