LETTER OF RECOMENDATION

SUBJECT: ENHANCEMENTS TO ELLIS WOODS PARK MULTI-PURPOSE COURT
DATE: 8/22/2017

COMMITTEE RECOMENDATION

The Coventry Parks, Recreation and Conservation Committee recommends the following three enhancements to Ellis Woods Park based on the guidelines of the newly adapted Open Space Plan.

- 1) The multi-purpose court be expanded for the following:
 - Double the size.
 - A second basketball net for a full court.
 - A second pickleball court
 - A wooden practice backboard for tennis, pickleball, soccer and such.
- 2) A cover for the play area to keep the equipment cool. The equipment getting too hot is a common complaint.
- 3) Improve the landscaping with more trees and plants.

The committee will research funding if the board supports this recommendation.
