



**EAST COVENTRY TOWNSHIP  
CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**

**THE FOLLOWING CATEGORIES SHALL BE USED AS THE BASIS FOR DETERMINING EXONERATIONS FROM PER CAPITA TAXES:**

**1. Low Income**

**Any person with an individual income of less than \$14,580 and, if married, a joint income of less than \$29,160 “Income” includes money from all sources, and includes but not limited to:**

- a. Money received from government programs such as Social Security, Public Assistance, and Unemployment Compensation.**
- b. Money received as interest or dividend payments.**
- c. Money received as salary or wages.**

**2. Student**

**Any person who is a full-time student at an accredited institution, with an annual income of less than \$14,580**

**3. Double Assessment**

**Any person who has paid a township per capita tax to another township to which tax was due and payable.**

**4. Military**

**Any person on active duty domiciled in another township, but presently living in East Coventry Township.**
