MINUTES OF THE EAST COVENTRY TOWNSHIP FOOD PROCESSING AND WATER QUALITY STEERING COMMITTEE SPECIAL MEETING HELD ON MAY 04, 2023

The Food Processing And Water Quality Steering Committee held a special meeting on Thursday, May 04, 2023. 1. Call to Order - Pledge of Allegiance.

2. Member Introductions.

3. Organization.

A. Consideration of Nominations and Election of Chair.

Mr. Preston made a motion to appoint Mr. Tietjen as Chair. Mr. Schur seconded the motion. Mr. Tietjen called for a vote and the motion passed 7-0-0.

B. Consideration of Nominations and Election of Vice Chair.

Mr. Price made a motion to appoint Mr. Preston as Vice Chair. Mr. Tietjen seconded the motion. Mr. Tietjen called for a vote and the motion passed 7-0-0.

C. Consideration of Nominations and Election of Recording Secretary.

Ms. Giovine made a motion to appoint Ms. Wright as Recording Secretary. Mr. Tietjen seconded the motion. Mr. Tietjen called for a vote and the motion passed 7-0-0.

4. New Business.

A. Consideration of Adopting a Mission Statement and Purpose Focused on Food Processing Residual and Water Quality Matters within the Township Consistent with Resolution Number 2023-08, Establishing this Ad Hoc Food Processing Residual and Water Quality Steering Committee.

The Committee discussed this item and decided upon the following mission statement and purpose: To provide the Board of Supervisors with advice, guidance, and recommendations on good stewardship and the protection of potential public and private drinking water sources located within the Township; including, but not limited to, the potential for local regulation of the storage and limitations on land application of food processing residual.

C. Review of the Food Processing Residual Application Ordinance. (Added at the Meeting.)

Mr. Tietjen made a motion to amend the agenda to begin reviewing the Food Processing Residual Application Ordinance. Mr. Preston seconded the motion. Mr. Tietjen called for a vote and the motion passed 7-0-0.

The Committee discussed notification of Ordinance to farmers, Township administration of the Ordinance, need to hire a professional to review testing results, testing process, transportation, spills/leaks, insurance by hauler/applier, and marking of minimum setbacks.

Mr. Briggs was asked to provide the Committee with a copy of the Nolt Trucking storage tank plans submitted with the Zoning Permit Application for an agricultural accessory structure.
