

**MINUTES FOR THE
EAST COVENTRY TOWNSHIP HISTORICAL COMMISSION
MEETING HELD ON MARCH 12, 2024**

The Historical Commission held its monthly meeting on Tuesday, March 12, 2024. Present for the meeting were Cathrine Subick, Chair; Larry Tietjen, Vice Chair; Peter Price, Secretary; Heather Peterman; and Katie Dinneen.

Call to Order – Pledge of Allegiance.

Ms. Subick called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and the pledge was recited.

1. Minutes.

A. Consideration of Approval of the February 13, 2024 Regular Meeting Minutes.

Ms. Subick made a motion to approve the minutes of the February 13, 2024 meeting. Mrs. Peterman seconded the motion. Ms. Subick called for a vote and the motion passed 5-0-0.

2. New Business.

A. Discuss Storm Damage at Fricks Lock.

Ms. Subick detailed recent damage at Fricks Lock Village. Repairs will be added to the 2024 scope of work and Constellation landscapers will remove the downed tree and other branches.

B. Discuss Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance Language.

The Commission discussed language to harmonize the Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance and Zoning Ordinance language to reference the 2003 Community Facilities Map by removing any reference to the Historic Resource Map and replacing it with the 2003 Community Facilities Map. Ms. Subick will follow up with a former Commission member for any history related to the issue.

A. Receive an Update on the Transportation Alternatives Set-aside Grant and the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission Grant Applications for the Ellis Hoffman Brick House at Fricks Lock.

Ms. Subick presented this item and informed the Commission that awards are expected to be announced by the end of April.

Jordan Rajan - Constellation: requested a tour of Fricks Lock Village be arranged for Constellation employees.


8. Other Business.
