

**MINUTES FOR THE
EAST COVENTRY TOWNSHIP
PARKS, RECREATION AND CONSERVATION COMMITTEE
REGULAR MEETING HELD ON JUNE 27, 2023**

The Parks, Recreation and Conservation Committee held a regular meeting on Tuesday, June 27, 2023. Present for the meeting were Bruce Stephens, Chair; Jason Stouch, Vice Chair; Flora Kapp, Secretary; Karen Nocella; Cathy Carney-Horner; Liz Willow; and Frank Coppo.

Call to Order – Pledge of Allegiance.

1. Minutes.

A. Approval of Minutes of the May 23, 2023 Monthly Meeting.

Willow made a motion to table this until requested information is received, Mr. Stouch seconded, Mr. Stephens called for a vote and the motion passed 7-0-0.

C. Consideration of Recommending the Submission of a Transportation Alternatives Set-Aside Grant Application for Stabilizing the Hoffman/Ellis Brick House at Fricks Lock.

1. Mrs. Nocella reviewed the above-mentioned grant which could be used to fund the repair of the Hoffman/Ellis Brick house at Fricks Lock which needs repair to the outside of the home. Tricia McCloskey/PARRC has asked if the Township would like her to move forward with the application. Mrs. Nocella made the motion to let Tricia/PARRC proceed with the application, Mrs. Carney-Horner seconded, Mr. Stephens called for a vote and the motion passed 7-0-0.
