**RESOLUTION NO. 2024-17**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXTENSION OF THE  
TIME IN WHICH INTERIM TAX BILLS MUST BE ISSUED  
TO A PROPERTY OWNER.**

**WHEREAS**, the East Coventry Township Board of Supervisors has appointed the East Coventry Township Tax Collector (the “Tax Collector”) as the municipal officer authorized to collect real estate taxes; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 5511.6 of the Local Tax Collection Law (72 P.S. § 5511.6) requires the Tax Collector to notify every taxpayer, whose name appears on a tax duplicate, of such duplicate, within thirty (30) days of its receipt “unless such time shall be extended by the taxing district”; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township desires to extend the time in which interim tax bills shall be issued to a taxpayer, who has appealed their property’s tax assessment, to ten (10) days following the Tax Collector’s receipt of notification of the hearing results from such appeal from the Chester County Board of Assessment Appeals.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of East Coventry Township, that effective immediately, the due date of interim tax bills for taxpayers, who have submitted a tax assessment appeal, shall be ten (10) days following the Tax Collector receiving notification of the appeal’s hearing results from the Chester County Board of Assessment Appeals. As of the effective date of this resolution, all prior ordinances and resolutions adopted by

this Board authorizing the collection of a fee for tax certification are vacated to the extent that they are inconsistent with this resolution.
